

Dhakis - The Dying Art

Ask a Bengali and they shall tell you what it means to welcome Maa Durga dancing to the beats of 'Dhak' - an old percussion instrument. This large hollow wooden instrument is covered on both ends with hide. Played either with bamboo sticks or hands, the instrument is slung over the shoulder, suspended from the neck or placed on the ground or lap.

The instrument is often decorated with white or multi-coloured feathers or traditional white flowers known as 'kaashphool'. Durga Pujo is inseparable from the 'Dhakis' whose resonating beats make the festival all the more joyous. Infact Pujo is not complete without the beats of Dhak. No "Aarti" can commence at any Pujo Pandal unless the dhakis start playing the dhak.

But sadly the art of playing a dhak is now referred to as a dying profession. The dhakis are generally from Malda & Midnapur districts of Bengal - they are landless farmers who also play dhak to earn some money during the festival. They travel to all parts of India




during the Pujo time to earn some livelihood. But face enough challenges travelling - due to security reasons they subjected to search and have to shell out money. Return journeys are more challenging as they also carry money back. Moreover they are paid a pittance for all their efforts. Moreover, Dhakis are losing out on technology, CD's with the Dhak beats are available and slowly many puja pandals are using these technologies.

It is in our best interest that we keep this tradition alive. One can never relate to a "Dhanuchi Naach" without the traditional beat of this fabulous art.

A quest for origin of the Ganges Pragna Das

River Ganga- has been carrying respect and emotion of millions ofIndians, has been witnessing the story of Indian history since its inception and said to be the mother of Indian civilization. Its main tributary- River Bhagirathi is originated from Gaumukh glacier at 4255 meter altitude.

Being a resident of Gurgaon, Haryana since 2008, I have encountered the story of Maa Ganga and many vivid description of this divine abode a number of times. Finally, we planned to visit this sacred and beautiful place in starting of May2018. It was my first trekking- so excitement erupted with full throttle, especially when we started to pack our rucksack with different survival kits.

Finally the big day had come. We- my family- my grandparents, parents, my 7 year brother and mestarted our journey by trainon10th May night from New Delhi to reach Dehradun the next morning. From local jeep stand, we took a jeep to reach Uttarkashi. Within 15 minutes our jeep crossed Dehradun City and started to ascent on hilly terrain. Slowly we were entering to our divine, the Himalayas. We take light breakfast at a road side dhaba while enjoying fresh air. While enjoying the ascent, we reach Uttarkashi at about 1:30 PM.

We had lunch at GMVN tourist lodge and arrange permission for Gaumukh from forest department office. After lunch, we started our next 100 KM journey to Gangotri. We were continuously being guided by the dancing Bhagirathi while greeted with number of water falls. We stopped several times to relax and to enjoy the scenic beauty around us and finally reached GMVN Tourist Rest House, Gangotri at 6:30 PM.

We decided to spend a full day at Gangotri before we start trekking to Gaumukh. We spend our day by visiting the famous Gangotri temple and acclimatized ourselves with small local trek to Pandav Gumpha. Although weather was very pleasant in full day- it turned really bad in evening. All of a sudden, lots of cloud covered the blue sky and it started raining cats and dogs. It was sufficient to destroy our excitement of next day trek.

13th May'2018:

The bad weather persisted till morning. Forest department, who allows trekkers to go uphill, held up all trekkers till they feel the weather is clear. There was a huge dilemma- whether to start our journey to Goumukh or not. My father was continuously following up with our guide: SriJagmohan Singh Rana, to get current update over forest department's decision. Finally at about 8:30 AM, Jagmohan ji passed on the green signal given by forest department- "Saab, taiyaar ho jaiye". We erupted with joy and excitement. We quickly prepared with our rucksacks and started our journey in search of origin of the Ganges.

At the start there was a steep slope that lead to a mule stables. Further a brisk walking of 1.5 KM took us to the forest check post. The guards on the check post were amazed to see Safalya- my brother- a 7 year kid, with such enthusiasm and excitement for Goumukh. We registered ourselves for Goumukh.

We started trekking towards Bhojbasa- further 12 KM away. I was in charge of me and my dear camera. I discovered that I and my brother were the fastest on the trail. I took pictures of the mountains on the path, ate chocolates and dates, hummed songs of every kind and rested on the rocks while my parents came behind. It was peaceful until one of the "nalas" came.

Nala is a small stream washed away the actual trekking route. A small handmade wooden bridge was there to cross it, which was placed on top of two rocks above a stream that joined the bustling river down below. To cross any bridge we had to climb down a steep slope then cross the bridge and finally climb up a steep slope and then again walk on the rocky trail.

After a further ascent of 3 KM, we could see domes of chir trees dotted in front of us. We became restless and started walking faster, but the rock covered path and the drizzling cold water made it difficult for us to gain speed. At about 2:30 PM, we reached Chirbasa. Chirbasa is called with this name as the area is covered with forest comprising chir trees. The scene is with lashing green and a real comfort for our eyes.



In Chirbasa, there is a small dhaba in a make shift tent which also have resting facility. We enjoyed warmth of hot maggie and tea as lunch. Our guide uncle offered everybody hot drinking water. Probably first time in my life, I have enjoyed drinking hot water so much. While we were having our lunch, it was started raining. Actually at this altitude, it was snow fall.

Again it was a gamble-whether to start for Bhujbasa or not. Bhujbasa was 5 KM ahead and we had a 7 year old member in our team. If the weather condition deteriorates, there is no resting place in between. Moreover we hadbeen informed that the trekking trail was more fierce ahead compared to that we had crossed till Chirbasa. It was 3:00 PM and we had to reach Bhojbasa before twilight. But considering the poor condition of staying in Chirbasa, it is always advisable to reach Bhujbasa. We left this decision to guide uncle and he decided to start for Bhujbasa. "We are what our thoughts have made us"- Swami Vivekananda and we decided to think- we would reach Bhujbasa safely. We started another 5 Kilometer we full confidence.

As we have started, the path was amazing. Although we were continuously ascending, Bhagirathi and Shivlinga peaks were greeting us all along. Throughout the path, Bhagirathi River was taking away our fatigue with her joyful dance. We understood 5 KM would be finished with flying colors.

But slowly sky was getting covered with clouds. Our guide uncle was getting tensed. Snowfall started. We quickly put on our rain coats- while taking a short break. I had seen snow before but I had never witnessed a snowfall. I was speechless at first and was enjoying the cold water as it melted on my cheeks but then I was struggling as it started snowing heavily.

After a one hour slow and tiring ascent, we reached landslide prone area. It was approximately a stretch of 500 meters. Path was getting narrower and dangerous. In one side, Bhagirathi was flowing 2000 ft below. Other side, it was with loose rocks, continuously falling from up hills. Every time we wanted a halt, guide uncle cautioned us not to stop. We were moving past the danger zone with slow pace. My brother started crying- his lips were bleeding. He was small and had never seen or done something like this. He was afraid. So the porter decided to carry him to bhojbasa while my parents came with me. Due to my speed I got separated from my family and lost my way.

The porter and my brother went ahead and my parents far behind and me in the middle, all alone, in this huge world trying to find my way. As I was walking two big stones that were size of a big water bottle came rushing down in front of me! I was extremely scared then. Soon came a diversion. There were 3 paths, one going up, one down and one in the middle. The middle one was the worst one so I took the upper one. The upper one lead me to nowhere. So I returned back. Then I took lower one and made a mistake as the rocks started sliding down as soon as I stepped on something. By sheer luck I made it out of there and an idea struck me. Mules were also travelling there and if there is a mule on the path, the path will be covered with its feces. So I started searching for feces and finally found a pile of them and followed that path. After climbing big rocks, crossing 2 streams and walking for about 1 and a half hour I reached Bhojbasa and saw my brother and the porter sitting on rocks. I was so happy to see them and I give my brother a tight hug.

Bhojbasa is surrounded with mountains and snow covered peaks. It's a dale in between of a crown of mounts. It was beautiful. We had found our place in GMVN trekker's hut. So we went there and sat on the ice cold bed and waited for my parents to arrive. About an hour later they came. That night we stargazed for a while then tried to sleep but couldn't because of the cold.

14th May'2018

The next day when we woke up we found patches of snow on the grass. Today's plan was to reach our destination: Gaumukh and back to trekkers hut.

After taking breakfast, we started for Gaumukh. Initial 2 Km was splendid. It was a sunny morning after last night snow fall. We enjoyed the trek while Shivlinga peak was inviting us with his glorious presence. The path is dotted with green patches as well as newly gather snow. As we were continuing for another 1 hour, path was getting diluted in rocky contour. We saw many small stone pillars made in the memory of a dead person.

We saw a huge stone that said "Gaumukh 1966". Our guide said: in the year 1966, it was the starting point of Gaumukh glacier. Due to global warming the glacier had melted and retreated few kilometers behind. We stood there for a while and pledged to be good towards our mother earth and reduce global warming. As we proceed further, huge stones started to block our way. We had to climb them to make



our way. After half an hour of climbing, we reached the zero point of Gaumukh glacier.

It was a breath taking view. Everything in this world- rock, sand, air, water and mountain peak was getting doubly illuminated with sun beam. In front of us, Bhagirathi river was emerging from the glacier surrounded by glorious Bhagirathi peak. It felt like a big drama was happening. Goddess Ganga is emerging from Lord Shiva's hair while the peaks salutes the great creation. We kept spellbound with this scene and tried to get this recorded in our permanent memory.

I started to take photos of everything possible. Our guide took a bath in the river while we filled out our bottles with fresh water. The place was so peaceful that we didn't want leave but it was about noon and we still had cover 4 km of gigantic rocks. So we began our walk to return to Bhojbasa.

When we were very near to Bhojbasa, we saw the rare blue deer, ghurral. It was a lucky day for us. Other than the ghurral there was this local species of bird that looked exactly like a crow but was actually a pigeon. A pigeon with pitch black body and yellow beak and claws. We returned GMVN Trekking hut at about 2:00 PM.

15th May:

The next morning we started at around 7:30 in the morning. I was excited as we were returning back and I would meet my grandparents again but I was also a little sad because we were leaving this beautiful place. Climbing down the mountain was easier than climbing up but it was painful for our knees and feet. But it was way better than climbing up and the weather was very pleasant that way.

We were continuously consuming dates as it was a constituent for water and refilled our energy. What felt like only 15 minutes but where 3 hours, we reached chirobasa. We rested there for a while then started walking again.

After passing chirbasa, and walking for about 2.5 hours, we saw the checkpost. Gangotri city was also visible a long way ahead. After a 30 minutes brisk walking, we reached the checkpost. Every guard in the check post congratulate us for finished this trekking unhurt. We returned all garbage we collected during this trekking. The forest officer praised us for this endevour. Now we started for final decent. We kept walking and finally reached GMVN Tourist Rest House. We rested there for that day.

16th May:

The next day we started our car ride from Gangotri at 8:00 AM and reached Uttarkashi by noon. There we reunited with our grandparents. Our plan was to visit Nehru Mountaineering Institute (NIM) and have lunch there in the cafeteria.

It took a while to get there and wanted to visit the museum, but the workers were renovating the museum so we couldn't. As soon as we were about to leave, one of the workers insisted to show whatever was there. So we went inside the half broken museum. Inside, it was a totally different world! It was beautiful! All the Chardhams were drawn in one place that also on 3dimensional models which looked so realistic that we could walk straight in them. There were different ranges painted and more were under construction.

Next day we reached Musoorie. Spending a full day there, we returned back to Delhi by train from Dehradun, to finish our guest for Gaumukh.

It was my first trekking and I wondered how many great learnings I have learned from nature. Wish my quest for Goumukh become the beginning of my continuous quest for nature and mountain.

Preface

Subhash Chandra Bose was one of India's greatest freedom fighter. He revived the Indian National Army, popularly known as 'Azad Hind Fauj' in 1943 which was initially formed in 1942 by Rash Behari Bose. Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose had visited London during pre-independence period to discuss the future of India, with the members of the Labor party. His sudden disappearance from Taiwan, led to surfacing of various theories, unfortunately none of which were investigated thoroughly by successive governments; leaving people in the dark about one of the most beloved leaders India has ever produced.



Life history of Subhash Chandra Bose

Subhash Chandra Bose was born on 23 January, 1897 in Cuttack (Orissa) to Janakinath Bose and Prabhavati Devi. Janakinath Bose was one of the successful lawyer in Cuttack and received the title of "Rai Bahadur". He, later became a member of the Bengal Legislative Council.

Subhash Chandra Bose was a very intelligent and sincere student but never had much interest in sports. He passed his B.A. in Philosophy from the Presidency College in Calcutta. He was strongly influenced by **Swami Vivekananda's** teachings and was known for his patriotic zeal as a student. He also adored Vivekananda as his spiritual Guru.

Start of the opposition to British by Subhash Chandra Bose

Subhash Chandra Bose decided to take revenge, after reading so many incidents about the exploitation of the fellow Indians by the British. In 1916, Subhash reportedly beat and thrashed one of his British teachers E F Otten. The professor made a racist remark against the Indian students. As a result, Subhash Chandra Bose was expelled from the Presidency College and banished from Calcutta University. The incident brought Subhash in the list of rebel-Indians. In December 1921, Bose was arrested and imprisoned for organizing a boycott of the celebrations to mark the Prince of Wales's visit to India.

Subhash Chandra Bose in Britain for ICS and return to India

Subhash Chandra Bose's father wanted him to become a civil servant and therefore, sent him to England to appear for the Indian Civil Service Examination. Bose was placed fourth with highest marks in English. But his urge for participating in the freedom movement was intense that in April 1921, Bose resigned from the coveted Indian Civil Service and came back to India. Soon, he left home to become an active member of India's independence movement. He, later joined the Indian National Congress, and also elected as the president of the Youth wing party.

Subhash Chandra Bose with Congress

Subhash Chandra Bose worked under the leadership of 'Chittaranjan Das, an active member of Congress in Calcutta. It was 'Chittaranjan Das, who along with Motilal Nehru,



left Congress and founded the Swaraj Party in 1922. Subhash would regard 'Chittaranjan Das as his political guru.

While 'Chittaranjan Das was busy in developing the national strategy, Subhash Chandra Bose played a major role in enlightening the students, youth and labourers of Calcutta. He was eagerly waiting to see India, as an independent, federal and republic nation.

Subhash Chandra Bose Vs. Congress

In freedom struggle congress was large organization. Subhash Chandra Bose became a strong leader in Congress and he made brave attempt to mould the entire party differently. Congress party was always lenient and never in a position to oppose. Saubhashbabu outrightly opposed this behavior. This opposition was against Gandhi's philosophy. Therefore Mahatma Gandhi and other leaders were hurt and since then they opposed him.

Congress party had undertaken a mission of opposing his every thought, insulting him and to stifle his highflying ambitions. In this maneuver of congress many a time he felt suffocated. Once there was a picture of 'Subhash Chandra Bose against entire congress party'. It was first election of congress that time. Usually closer aide of Mahatma Gandhi used to get elected; but this time Subhash Chandra Bose got elected with higher votes. This insulted Gandhi group, which lead to their less interest of thinking towards party's campaign for independence.

In order to acknowledge outside support and get freedom he journeyed to far away Germany, Japan when it was period of 2nd world war! He decided to induce soldiers from outside to get freedom. Nehru at that time said "If Subhash would bring soldiers from outside and enter India, and then I would be the first person to wield a sword and oppose him." That was the extent to which he detested Subhash babu.

Formation of Azad Hind Fauj by Subhash Chandra Bose

Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose was against rendering any kind of help to the British during the World War II. He warned them so. The Second World War broke out in September of 1939, and just as predicted by Bose, India was declared as a warring state (on behalf of the British) by the Governor General, without consulting Indian leaders. The Congress party was in power in seven major states and all state governments resigned in protest.

Subhash Chandra Bose now started a mass movement against utilizing Indian resources and men for the great war. To him, it made no sense to further bleed poor Indians for the sake of colonial and imperial nations. There was a tremendous response to his call and the British promptly imprisoned him. He took to a hunger-strike, and after his health deteriorated on the 11th day of fasting, he was freed and was placed under house arrest. The British could do nothing except locking him in the prison.

It was in 1941, that Subhash Chandra Bose suddenly disappeared. The authorities did not come to know for many days that he was not in his Barrack (the house in which he was being guarded). He traveled by foot, car and train and resurfaced in Kabul (now in Afghanistan), only to disappear once again. In November 1941, his broadcast from German radio sent shock waves among the British and electrified the Indian masses who realized that their leader was working on a master plan to free their motherland. It also gave fresh confidence to the revolutionaries in India who were challenging the British in many ways.



The Axis powers (mainly Germany) assured Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose military and other help to fight the British. Japan by this time had grown into another strong world power, occupying key colonies of Dutch, French, and British colonies in Asia. Netaji Bose had struck alliance with Germany and Japan. He rightly felt that his presence in the East would help his countrymen in freedom struggle and second phase of his saga began. It is told that he was last seen on land near Kiel Canal in Germany, in the beginning of 1943. A most hazardous journey was undertaken by him under water, covering thousands of miles, crossing enemy territories. He was in the Atlantic, the Middle East, Madagascar and the Indian ocean. Battles were being fought over land, in the air and there were mines in the sea. At one stage he traveled 400 miles in a rubber dingy to reach a Japanese submarine, which took him to Tokyo. He was warmly received in Japan and was declared the head of the Indian army, which consisted of about 40,000 soldiers from Singapore and other eastern regions. These soldiers were united by another great revolutionary Rash Behari Bose. Rash Behari handed over them to Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. Netaji Bose called it the Indian National Army (INA) and a government by the name "Azad Hind Government" was declared on the 21st of October 1943. INA freed the Andaman and Nicobar islands from the British and were renamed as Swaraj and Shaheed islands. The Government started functioning.

Subhash Chandra Bose wanted to free India from the Eastern front. He had taken care that Japanese interference was not present from any angle. Army leadership, administration and communications were managed by Indians only. Subhash Brigade, Azad Brigade and Gandhi Brigade were formed. INA marched through Burma and occupied Coxtown on the Indian Border. A touching scene ensued when the soldiers entered their 'free' motherland. Some lay down and kissed, some placed pieces of mother earth on their heads, others wept. They were now inside India and were determined to drive out the British! Delhi Chalo (Let's march to Delhi) was the war cry.

The bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki changed the history of mankind. Japan had to surrender.

Effect of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose's earlier visits to England

During his sojourn to England, he met with the leaders of British Labor Party and political thinkers including Clement Attlee, Arthur Greenwood, Harold Laski, G.D.H. Cole, and Sir Stafford Cripps. Bose also discuss with them about the future of India. It must also be noted that it was during the regime of the Labor Party (1945-1951), with Attlee as the Prime Minister, that India gained independence.


Disappearance of Subhash Chandra Bose

Although it was believed that Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose died in a plane crash, his body was never recovered. There have been many theories put forward regarding his disappearance. The government of India set up a number of committees to investigate the case and come out with truth.

In May 1956, the Shah Nawaz Committee visited Japan to look into the situation of Bose's assumed death. Citing their lack of political relations with Taiwan, the Centre, did not seek for the assistance from their government. The reports of Justice Mukherjee Commission, tabled in Parliament on 17 May, 2006 said, "Bose did not die in the plane crash and the ashes at Renkoji temple are not his". However, the findings were rejected by the government of India.




Through the looking "Glass"



WHEN MAA BECKONS

(A different view of the Sahasrabdi Durga Puja Committee's godliness)

The heart adds an extra beat even 38 years after leaving Calcutta (Kolkatta) when I smell the whiff of Durga Puja in the air. Being the formative years of my life, I came away blessed from Calcutta, having learnt to walk a path where I try to emulate Swami Vivekananda in thoughts, and Mother Teresa in the use of my hands for service to the poor and needy. This year, given a platform in an NCR magazine, I chose to write about our Southcity-I Sahasrabdi Durga Puja Committee, in the September issue, so that my locality's Pandal may get higher advocacy and footfalls. Dialing old Bengali ' bhadrolok' contacts, I was guided to Mr. Subhasis Maitra, the General Secretary of this year's Puja Committee. A nice conversation flowed, and as he outlined the various activities to help my article, he emphasised that the Committee's focus was on CSR this year. They were doing a Blood Donation camp, and collection of food, clothes and books for multiple charities. I loved the way he emoted positive vibes even on telephone.

As the maverick who loves to help the needy, I devote 3 days a week to an Old Age Home and the rest to office and other children, environment and animal charities. This Home, (The Earth Saviours Foundation), founded by a deeply motivated soul, Mr. Ravi Kalra, is located at Bandhwari, on the Gurgaon - Faridabad Road has over 450 inmates who are either abandoned old or destitute picked up from the roadside. More than 90% are both mentally and physically challenged. It is a kind Home and I love to do hands on community service there. While many support it with food and resources, rarely do the 30-40 odd sane and healthy inmates get a chance for an outing. That outing is something they have always requested me to organise. So, as I wrote for the 'Samvada' September edition, something inside me nudged me to speak to Subhasis with a very far-fetched request. I asked him if it would be possible to host a lunch outing to the Pandal for these 30-40 friends of mine, as an extension of their CSR theme.

Subhasis was positive as he heard my request. He said it can be possible, but obviously, he has to take approval from the Committee Presidents, Mr. S C Dutta and Mr. P K Ghatak, and other members of the Committee. He was able to swing the deal soon enough, and fortunately, when the ladies team from the Pandal, led by the President's wife, Mrs. Bobby Dutta, visited the Home to do a personal assessment, I had the honor of meeting these ladies too, as I sat in the medical room, doing dressings for the inmates. One small meeting. And in her smile and the goodness in her eyes, I saw that, Bobby would enable my friends a wonderful afternoon outing. And she did.

The date was fixed at Saptami, 16 Oct afternoon. A total of 41 members from the Home, walking



and on wheel-chairs, including 8 escorts and staff helpers debussed at Blessings Lawn, Sector 40, Gurgaon, at noon. Normally, it takes effort and coercion to get them to have a bath and get ready, but as Rakhi, their Senior Social Worker informed me, they were ready at sunrise for this outing. Subhasis, Bobby and a number of volunteer ladies, dressed in traditional and regal Bengali attire, received the guests at the entrance and guided them to the main Pandal. Other ladies applied tilak, distributed 'charnamat and prasad', even as the 'Dhak' pair rent the air with their lovely rhythmic drum beats. While school children entertained the guests with a 'nukkad natak' on 'Swatchch Bharat' theme, the ladies enthralled them with the traditional dance with lighted fragrant 'Loban' in clay 'Dhunas', a dance of reverence and respect performed to honor Maa Durga. Others moved around, chatting up, holding their hands and making the guests feel inclusive.

The piety over, we moved to the main hall, where a professional singer had most of our men and women who could stand un-supported, dancing to her tune. The hostesses joined in. Happiness pervaded. Compassion changed to love. Veena, from our flock, even took to the stage to sing along. Pretty gutsy of her I would say. As the clock moved, some of the inmates were given the mike to narrate their story. Tears flowed freely. They always do. A wonderful 'bhog' lunch of superbly made bengali khichdi, the quintessential baigun bhaja and chutney, followed by the halwa and rasogulla, had the guests smiling contentedly. Those who were on fast, got fruits. The organisers had done their homework well and with deep commitment apparently. And as they trudged out after a Group photograph, weary, yet fulfilled, each inmate was presented a blanket to add to their joy.

Each time I have gone back to the Home after this outing, some still give me the thumbs up sign, others ask me when I would take them out again. When I asked Mr. Gupta, the senior most guest who experienced the Maa Durga afternoon, how he felt, he said, 'It was wonderful. Such outings add a fillip to our lives and I wish you can organise more or people can call us out more.' To me, as a small facilitator, the experience gave me happiness because my brood enjoyed it. To the entire Bengali community behind this gracious gesture, and especially Subhasis and Bobby, the benign Maa had beckoned, and they responded well. I am indebted to all for their kindness and compassion. People come and donate. As Indians we all do that, but it is the ones especially blessed, who give the destitute time and personal care and love. To gift more than 4 hours of a Puja time afternoon was priceless, and I hope the Committee's association with the Home will bring the inmates more joy and the community contentment in heart and soul, in times to come. That Maa Durga liked what they did, is apparent, as the same evening, they got news of being adjudged the 2nd best Pandal out of 22 in Gurgaon. I am a believer, and I believe "She" gifted the win.



वह चार दशकों से भारतीय संसद के सदस्य थे, लोकसभा, निचले सदन, दस बार, और दो बार राज्य सभा, ऊपरी सदन में चुने गए थे। उन्होंने लखनऊ के लिए संसद सदस्य के रूप में कार्य किया, 2009 तक उत्तर प्रदेश जब स्वास्थ्य संबंधी चिंताओं के कारण सिक्रय राजनीति से सेवानिवृत्त हुए। अपना जीवन राष्ट्रीय स्वयंसेवक संघ के प्रचारक के रूप में आजीवन अविवाहित रहने का संकल्प लेकर प्रारम्भ करने वाले वाजपेयी राष्ट्रीय जनतांत्रिक गठबंधन (राजग) सरकार के पहले प्रधानमन्त्री थे, जिन्होंने गैर काँग्रेसी प्रधानमन्त्री पद के ५ साल बिना किसी समस्या के पूरे किए। उन्होंने २४ दलों के गठबंधन से सरकार बनाई थी जिसमें ८१ मन्त्री थे।

२००५ से वे राजनीति से संन्यास ले चुके थे और नई दिल्ली में ६-ए कृष्णामेनन मार्ग स्थित सरकारी आवास में रहते थे। १६ अगस्त २०१८ को एक लम्बी बीमारी के बाद अखिल भारतीय आयुर्विज्ञान संस्थान, दिल्ली में श्री वाजपेयी का निधन हो गया। वे जीवन भर भारतीय राजनीति में सक्रिय रहे।


